## Campus Dining Meal Plans

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2009-2010 academic year. ## Meal Cards

Selection of a Campus Dining Services Meal Plan entitles you to a Colonel Card, which allows you purchasing power equivalent to the plan you have selected. Here is how it works: All students living in the residence halls must be on a meal plan. The meal plan options are designed to meet the needs of any active college student. As a student you have a choice of three meal plans, each with three different tiers. These provide you a guaranteed number of meals per week. Each meal plan includes Munch Money, or declining balance dollars, that are subtracted from your Munch Money account each time you select that payment option. Munch Money works like a credit card, only in reverse. The Munch Money value with the meal plan you choose is entered onto your card into the computer system. Each time you make a Munch Money purchase, our computer will deduct the amount of that purchase from your Colonel Card Meal Plan account.

## Lost Your Colonel Card?

Lost or stolen cards can be replaced. Should this happen to you report the loss immediately either in person or by telephone to the Colonel Card Office at 985-448-4498 in the Student Union to prevent unauthorized use of your card, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30a.m. and 4:30p.m. or you may deactivate your card by visiting <http://www.nicholls.edu/colonelcard>.

We do have a food take out policy, you just have to notify the cashier at the time you enter the dining room that you wish to take your food out and the cashier will provide you with the proper take out containers and explain the take out policy to you.

## Dining Policies and Procedures

One of our main goals is to provide a pleasant, clean, comfortable and satisfying dining experience. In order to meet this goal, we ask for your assistance with the following procedures.

- Please bus your tray and disposables from your table when you have finished dining.
- Please refrain from taking food, dishes or utensils from the dining area.
- Remember that meal cards are non-transferable. Meal cards cannot be used by anyone but the purchaser.
- When you enter the dining hall or want to make a purchase using Munch Money at one of the Student Union dining locations, you must have your Colonel Card with you for scanning.
- For security purposes, you will not be allowed to eat in the dining hall or make a Munch Money purchase without your Colonel Card.
- Enjoy all the food selections you want at each visit to the dining hall, but please remember, take what you want, but eat what you take! Please don't waste food.

A. Lost cards must be reported immediately! Contact the Colonel Card Office located in the Student Union for assistance.

A. Yes, we have an express meal service available.
